Nominator:	Public payer
Nomination Summary:	Population(s): Children with a diagnosis of severe emotional disorder (SED) Intervention(s): Intensive residential treatment (IRT), pharmacological treatment, counseling, psychotherapy, etc. Comparator(s): For IRT, therapy provided in a non-residential setting Outcome(s): Increase in positive behavior, quicker return to community
Key Questions from Nominator:	1. What is considered effective and evidence-based treatment for children with SED with aggressive behaviors?
